

The French-Finnish meeting "*Chemistry for protection of global environment*" will take place at the Academy of Finland (Vilhonvuorenkatu 6) on 6 September 2007.

The goal of this seminar is to stimulate two facets of the bilateral cooperation. The first one aims at initiating joint research proposals within the frame of the 2008 calls Sustainable Energy (Academy of Finland) and Sustainable Chemistry (Agence Nationale de la Recherche, France). The second one aims at launching an international graduate school on the relevant topic. The meeting will be a free open one-day seminar.
