



Visibility of European Union RRF funding: Communicating the origin of funding in physical research infrastructures

In accordance with <u>Regulation (EU) 2021/241</u> on the RRF and the RRF-specific terms and conditions, the beneficiary of the funding shall, in all communications of the project, display the origin of the funding and ensure visibility of the European Union funding by presenting both the Union logo and the words 'Funded by the European Union — NextGenerationEU'. The EU logo is the primary visual identifier used to indicate the origin of funding and ensure visibility of the European Union and EU funding. If other logos are also displayed, the EU logo must be at least the same size as the largest of the other logos.

If RRF funding has been used to acquire, for example, physical research equipment or to finance the operation of a physical research laboratory or other physical research infrastructure, the origin of the funding must be mentioned, and EU funding visibility ensured with the emblem. The Research Council of Finland has provided 'Funded by NextGenerationEU' stickers to recipient organisations for further distribution. The sticker must be affixed to the equipment or space acquired with RRF funding in a visible location.

In inspections related to RRF projects, attention is paid to the visibility of the funding origin and related communication.
