

## Textile refinement / automatic sorting plant 2025-2026?

- Enables the recycling of household end-of-life textiles in Finland -sorting capacity in the <u>first phase 10,000 t/a = 2 to 2,5 kg per residents in Finland</u>
- The direct employment impact of the processing plant is estimated at 50-100 people/a.
- Investment 20 to 25 M€ (RRF funding granted by Business Finland 5,17 M€
- => The refinement capacity exists or will be build, but <u>collection and sorting</u> <u>capacity is lacking in EU</u>

## **INVESTMENT STATUS:**

- 1. Due to slowly coming legislation for textile waste (WFD) +
- 2. Impossibility of applying for extension of RRF funding
- = Probable withdrawal from the project implementation if partners cannot be found
