Why is the CV under my account listed as an attachment to the application in the confirmation message I received after submission?

Only the CV entered on the application form will be part of the application. The CV mentioned in the confirmation message will not be appended to the application. This mention will be removed from messages to be sent later.

Adding publications and other outputs in consortium applications

The consortium PI adds the most relevant publications and other key outputs on behalf of the whole consortium. No more than 10 publications and 10 outputs per consortium.

Progress reports

There is no need to write a progress report on the funding of a consortium party (no final report has been submitted). These decisions are not shown on the 'Progress reports' tab.

Aligning text with both margins in the research plan

The research plan editor does not allow justifying the text, in other words you cannot align the text with both margins. According to the guidelines, the text is left-aligned (see <u>Guidelines for research plan</u> <u>template</u>).

Paragraph indentation does not work in the research plan editor

Why can't I edit the application? Why aren't the application fields active?

'Collaborators' tab in Academy Research Fellow and Postdoctoral Researcher application forms

In the call text, applicants have been instructed to describe the key merits of collaborators in terms of the project and justify their choices in section 3.2 of the research plan. Unfortunately, the application form included an invalid tab associated with this same issue. The tab was deleted, which also then removed the collaborator descriptions provided on that tab.

This change was notified to the applicants concerned by email on 16 September, in case they had failed to notice the notification posted in the online services (SARA) on 15 September.

Our aim is to avoid making changes in the system while the call is open, but both we and applicants are obliged to follow what is stated in the call text.
