European & Developing Countries Clinical Trials Partnership (EDCTP)

The European & Developing Countries Clinical Trials Partnership EDCTP (www.edctp.org) funds clinical research to accelerate the development of new or improved drugs, vaccines, microbicides and diagnostics against HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis and malaria as well as other poverty-related infectious diseases in sub-Saharan Africa.

The EDCTP programme will be executed through partnerships between European and African institutions and researchers in collaboration with the pharmaceutical industry and like-minded organisations. The programme is implemented as part of the European Framework Programme for Research and Innovation, Horizon 2020 and governed by the participating African and European countries.

EDCTP promotes synergies and complementariness between the centrally managed EDCTP activities – which are mainly funded by cash funding from the EU – and the *Participating States Initiated Activities (PSIAs)* – which are funded and managed by the EDCTP member states. The Academy of Finland contributes to the programme by the Development research funding scheme.
