







Academy funding in 2022 by funding opportunity



Finnish Flagship Programme

The Academy of Finland's Flagship Programme is an instrument that supports highquality research and increases the economic and societal impact emerging from the research. The Finnish Flagships represent an effective mix of close cooperation with business and society, adaptability and a strong commitment from host organisations. International collaboration is an integral part of the Flagships' activities.



Flagship status requires a long history of high-quality research and impact.

Research infrastructures

The Academy of Finland provides funding for the acquisition, establishment or upgrading and expansion of nationally significant research infrastructures that promote scientific research.

The aim of the research infrastructure funding is to improve the quality, renewal, competitiveness and interdisciplinarity of Finnish research and to increase the appeal of Finnish research environments.

RESEARCH INFRASTRUCTURES

Instruments, equipment, information networks, databases, materials and services Serve to facilitate research, promote research collaboration and reinforce research and innovation capacity and know-how.

May be single-sited, distributed or virtual, or a combination of these.

DIVERSE IMPACT OF RESEARCH INFRASTRUCTURES

Are used to produce approximately 7,000 scientific articles annually in Finland. The number of users varies from 100 users to thousands per year. Approximately 50% of the RIs have significant business cooperation. Training

In 2022, our funding for research amounts to 468 million euros. We are a government agency within the administrative branch of the Finnish Ministry of Education, Science and Culture.
