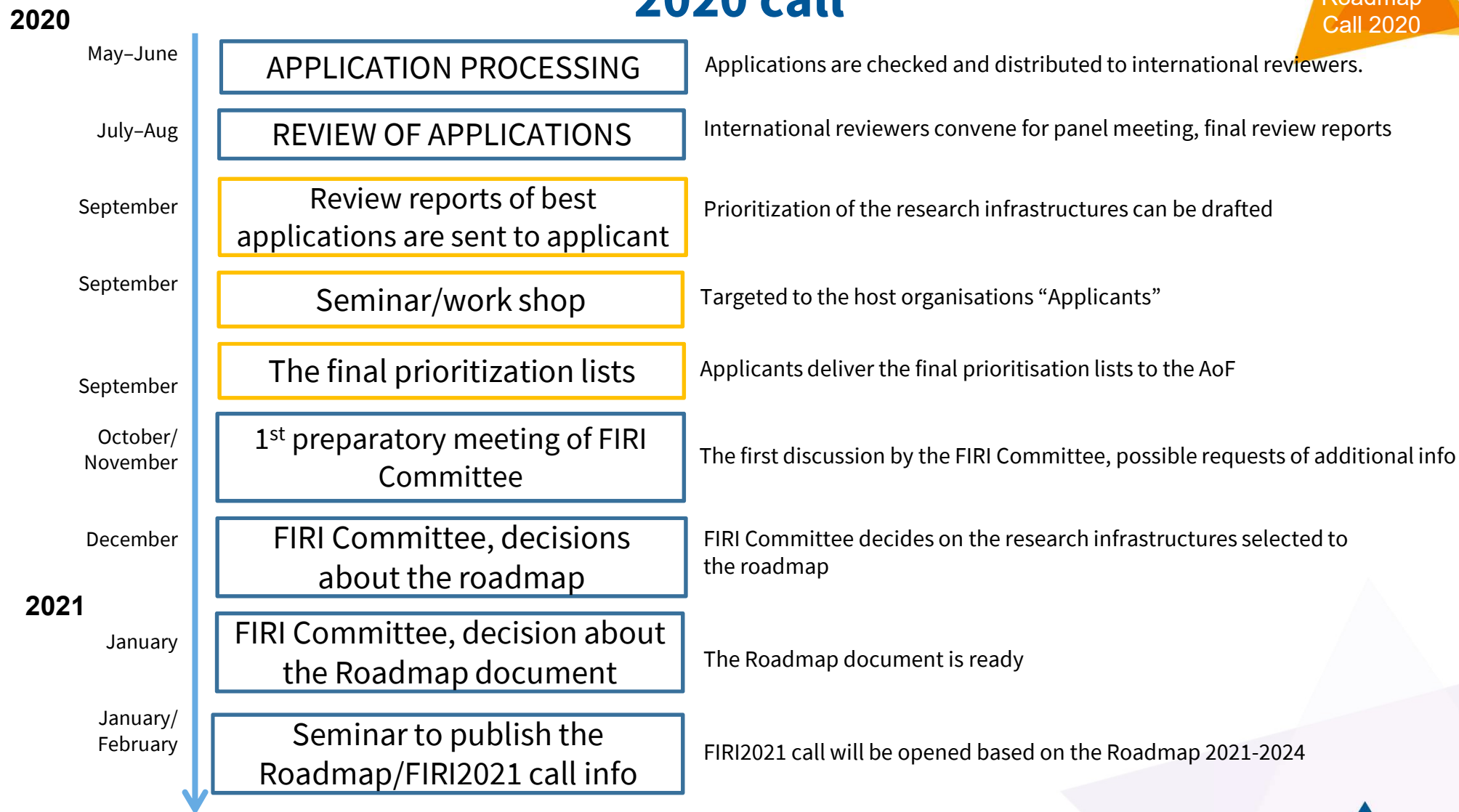
The FIRI Roadmap call 2020 in a nutshell



- **FIRI Roadmap call 2020:** 04/2020-27.5.2020
- **The length of the roadmap period:** 4 years (2021-2024)
- **Applicant:** research organisation
- *Prioritization:*
 - list of research infrastructures, which are allowed to apply needs to be attached to the application.
 - final "real" prioritization will be in the autumn of 2020
- **The FIRI Roadmap call 2020 is NOT A FUNDING CALL!**
- *Finland's Research Infrastructure Committee has aligned that most of the funding in the coming FIRI calls (FIRI2021 and FIRI2023) will be reserved to the Roadmap RIs*
- **Decisions:** December 2020
- **The next funding call FIRI2021 will be opened in spring 2021**

*FIRI = Finnish Research Infrastructure

How will different research infrastructures apply?

- There will only be one call targeted to all:
 - Research infrastructures on the current roadmap
 - New initiatives and research infrastructures outside the current roadmap
 - Finland's international memberships?
 - National nodes (mostly ESFRIs) apply like other roadmap infrastructures
 - ACTRIS-FI, ICOS-FI, EATRIS-FI, ELIXIR-FI, Infrafrontier-FI, EU-OPENSOURCE-FI, Instruct-FI, Euro-BioImaging-FI, PRACE-FI, CLARIN-FI, CESSDA-FI, ESS-FI.
 - Separate monitoring process:
 - Head offices located in Finland (ICOS-ERIC and Euro-BioImaging ERIC, ACTRIS)
 - International memberships, which membership fees are paid through AoF
 - Eiscat, GBIF, ICDP, IODP, EMBL, CERN, ESO, ESRF, FAIR, MAXIV, IML, NeIC
- > Memberships will be listed to the Roadmap document

- International peer-review (panel)
 - Criteria for national RIs
 - The life cycle of the RI will be taken into account - like the "minimal key requirements" of the ESFRI

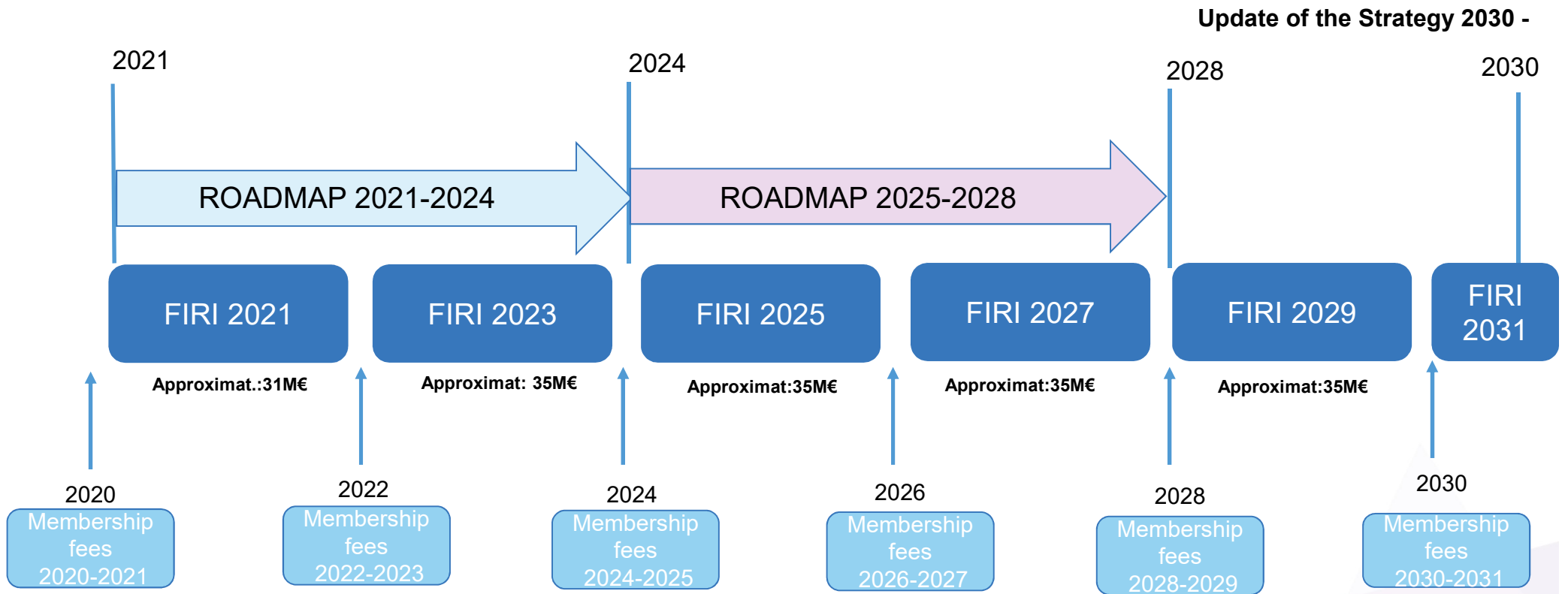
