
### SETTING THE STAGE: INTERMEDIARIES IN ENERGY DEVELOPMENT

- Assessing Intermediary Expertise in Cross-Border Arctic Energy Development project aims:
  - to improve understandings of how intermediaries drive the location and content of pivotal conversations on Arctic oil and natural gas development
  - Intermediaries = experts, professionals, firms, consultants, research communities etc...
- Focus on different types of expert knowledge
  - Apolitical & descriptive vs. socially constructed & performative
    - > makes certain kind of (energy) futures into being



# CASE STUDY: ARCTIC (SOCIAL) SCIENCE AS AN INTERMEDIARY

- Social aspects of Arctic energy developments often overlooked
  - ≠ socieoconomics / jobs and income
  - ≠ indigenous peoples & rights
- Arctic Council: policy-shaping intergovernmental entity
  - knowledge production to foster and promote regional sustainable development
  - Science to support decision-making

## SOCIAL SUSTAINABILITY (SCIENCE DRIVING ENERGY DEVELOPMENT

- Energy (= oil and gas) development as a prerequisite for (socially) sustainable development in the Arctic region
- Regionalized sustainability in a systems world
  - Maximizing benefits and (indigenous) participation
  - Minimizing impacts in the Arctic region
- Regional development but at what (global) cost?
  - Reports: Arctic communities challenged by climate change
  - "Clean" regional production does not solve emissions from O & G consumption
    - > Fueling "development", fueling climate change
