Akatemiatutkijan rahoituksen saaneet

Terveystutkimuksen toimikunnalle osoitettiin 29.10.2010 päättyneessä haussa 61 akatemiatutkijahakemusta. Terveystutkimuksen toimikunta päätti kokouksessaan 8.6.2011 myöntää akatemiatutkijan palkkausrahoituksen ajalle 1.9.2011 - 31.8.2016 seuraaville 11 hakijalle:

Kukin hakija voi lukea hakemuksestaan saamansa lausunnon käyttäjätunnuksillaan Akatemian verkkoasioinnissa. **Rahoituksen maksaminen edellyttää hakijan sekä suorituspaikan vahvistusta rahoituksen vastaanottamisesta Akatemian verkkoasioinnin (<https://asiointi.aka.fi/sahas>) / Omat hakemukset kautta kahden viikon kuluessa päätöspäivästä (22.6.2011 mennessä).**

Akatemiasta otetaan yhteyttä akatemiatutkijan rahoituksen saaneisiin ja heitä pyydetään jättämään tarkennettu hakemus välttämättömiin tutkimuskuluihin. Suorituspaikan on otettava tutkija palvelussuhteeseen päätöksen ehtojen mukaisesti. Varasijalla oleviin otetaan yhteyttä vain, mikäli joku nyt valituista luopuu tehtävästä.

Hakemukset olivat korkeatasoisia. Vain noin 18 % hakemuksista voitiin rahoittaa. Tästä johtuen monia erittäin hyvät arviot saaneita hakijoita jäi tälläkin kertaa vaille rahoitusta.

I Finlands Akademis utlysning som avslutades 29.10.2010 mottog forskningsrådet för hälsa sammanlagt 61 ansökningar om forskaranställning som akademiforskare. Forskningsrådet har vid sitt möte 8.6.2011 beslutat bevilja följande elva sökande finansiering för akademiforskares avlöning för perioden 1.9.2011–31.8.2016:

Om någon av de sökande som beviljats finansiering inte tar emot eller avstår från en forskaranställning som akademiforskare före 31.12.2011, kan forskningsrådet i stället välja en sökande från reservlistan för resten av perioden. Forskningsrådets beslut om reservlistan var följande:

3. Grönroos Tove, Åbo universitet

Alla som har sökt forskaranställning som akademiforskare får ett e-postmeddelande om beslutet efter att det har fattats. Var och en kan läsa utlåtandet om sin ansökan i Akademiens e-tjänst. För att finansieringen kan utbetalas krävs att den ansvariga ledaren och forskningsplatsen bekräftar att de tar emot finansieringen. Bekräftelsen ska göras i Akademiens e-tjänst (<https://asiointi.aka.fi/sahas>, under Mina ansökningar) inom två veckor från beslutsdagen, dvs. senast 22.6.2011.

Akademin kontaktar dem som fått akademiforskarfinansiering och ber dem lämna in en detaljerad ansökan om nödvändiga forskningskostnader. Forskningsplatsen måste anställa forskaren i ett anställningsförhållande i enlighet med beslutsvillkoren. De som placerats på reservlistan kontaktas endast ifall någon finansieringsmottagare avstår från sin anställning.

Ansökningarna höll genomgående en hög standard. Endast cirka 18 procent av ansökningarna kunde finansieras. Därför blev många ansökningar som fått en utmärkt bedömning också denna gång utan finansiering.

If an applicant who was granted funding in this call decides not to accept or to give up a research post as Academy Research Fellow before 31 December 2011, an applicant placed on the reserve list can be given a substitute position for the rest of the period. The Research Council decided to draw up a reserve list as follows:

All applicants for research posts as Academy Research Fellow will receive an email notification after the funding decision has been made. Applicants may read the expert reviews issued on their application by logging in to the Academy's online services with their user ID. **Before the funding can be paid, the principal investigator and the site of research must confirm that they will accept the funding. The confirmation must be done via the online services (<https://asiointi.aka.fi/sahas>, under My applications) within two weeks from the decision date, i.e. by 22 June 2011.**

The Academy will contact those who are granted funding for Academy Research Fellows and request them to submit a detailed application for necessary research costs. The site of research shall hire the researcher in an employment relationship in accordance with the conditions specified in the decision. Those placed on the reserve list will be contacted only if a grantee gives up his/her research post.

All applications submitted within the call were of a high standard. The Research Council could fund only some 18 per cent of the applications submitted and, once again, many applicants who received very good marks could not be granted funding.
