t of access by the data subject
data subject has the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to ther personal data concerning them are being processed, and, where that e case, access to the personal data. On request, the controller shall ide a copy of the personal data undergoing processing. The request ald be addressed to the contact person of the controller.
ided that the data subject requests the abovementioned copy more uently than once a year, the controller will charge a reasonable fee based dministrative costs.
t to rectification
data subject has the right to obtain from the controller without undue y the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning them. The est should be addressed to the contact person of the controller.
t to restrict processing
data subject has the right to obtain from the controller a restriction of essing, for example when the accuracy of the personal data is contested he data subject, for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy e personal data. Where processing has been restricted, such personal data l, with the exception of storage, only be processed with the data subject's sent or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims or for the ection of the rights of another natural or legal person or for reasons of ortant public interest of the European Union or of a Member State.
t to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority



Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, every data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State of their habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement, if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to them infringes the General Data Protection Regulation.
